First prepare a USB by creating a folder/container named "*theme*", inside it copy the . apk themes you are interested in. Here are some, but you can select/install only one at a time (it will be well explained later).



Disconnect internet and open the apk Theme



Select the light blue circled icon.



Clear application data.



Once the data is deleted, the car radio restarts immediately, showing the desktop with the default theme " *free* " without any other options.

Go back into the *Theme application* ... this screen should open, confirm " Agree "





(here depicting a stylized person...)



As you can see, only the default theme remained, having deleted all the application data...

On this window select the "*U disk import*" button, at this point, with the USB already connected to the car radio, the theme or themes that are inserted in the "*theme*" folder will open... not only in the USB but also those contained in the internal memory (same "*theme*" folder) of the car radio.



From here on, all the themes in the "theme" folders are listed, as specified above...





After choosing the desired theme, select it and press " Import "



Enjoy the brand new beautiful theme you have chosen.
